RESOLUTION NO. 120-21/22 Candidates' Statements of Qualifications

WHEREAS, Section 10012 of the Elections Code of the State of California requires the Livermore Valley Joint Unified School District Board of Education to adopt certain policies in regard to statements of qualifications for candidates who run for the office of member of the Governing Board of the District; and

WHEREAS, instructions in regard to candidates' statements are set forth in Elections Code 13307; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Governing Board does hereby determine as follows:

That all candidates submitting a statement of qualifications, which will be automatically printed in English, Spanish and Chinese, shall be charged for such printing;

That, as a condition of having his/her statement included in the voter's pamphlet, the candidate must pay the Alameda and/or Contra Costa County Registrar of Voters the sum of \$500 in advance to cover the cost estimated for each election;

That the statement of qualifications shall not exceed 200 words;

That the candidates not be permitted to submit additional materials to be sent to the voter with the sample ballot; and

That the Registrar of Voters be directed to give a copy of these regulations to each candidate or their representative at the time they pick up their nomination papers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these policies shall remain in full force and effect until rescinded by this Board.
