I am writing to you today because for the 3rd time in the past month and at 3 different schools, I walked into the Administrative office and found unmasked staff members. The staff members did quickly put on masks when they noticed me entering the office. I find this disturbing because my children have to wear a mask the entire time they're inside while at school but the adults apparently believe that they are above the rules.

To be honest, I would prefer if the masking requirement went away for everyone at the schools but as long as the students are required to mask while inside I believe that the adults need to as well. The double standard is at best hypocritical.

Again from January 3rd to February 3rd at all 3 schools that my children attend, adults in the administrative office were maskless while the kids had to remain masked. I expect this to be addressed and I would prefer that the school district remove the scientifically unfounded mask mandate on children but if you insist on continuing, the adults need to follow the rules as well.
