Things you should be focused/worried about:

-Flipped classes are a joke and are not beneficial to the student...just the teacher. Teachers are using their recorded lessons from distance learning in place of actually teaching. Many are just phoning it in and this is supported as quality.

-Making mask wearing a choice and not discriminating against the kids who want to breathe fresh air. Your mask mandate exceeds the state's authority, is not supported by evidence, and causes harm to children. Multiple studies examining school mask mandates have failed to find any epidemiological benefit from such policies.
